Students placed at the Bluegrass Rape Crisis Center [BRCC] use their talents, interests and passion to advocate for and support victims of sexual violence. We are a committed community network of individuals striving to put an end to all violence; through service, education and intervention we work to show survivors that they are not alone.

Student Roles Include:

- Answering our crisis hotline during office hours (Monday – Friday, 9 am – 5pm) and responding after hours from home as part of our volunteer base.
- Advocating for victims of sexual violence in our local emergency rooms during business hours and after hours as part of our volunteer base.
- Provide information and resources to those affected by sexual violence.
- Greet survivors and direct them to their clinician during business hours.
- Take information of potential clients, and pass it along to BRCC staff.

Bachelor's level students will be managed and provided with ongoing supervision by BRCC's Crisis Response Coordinator.
